In Northeast Florida, too many babies die from preventable causes and lack of health services. At Healthy Start, we believe that every baby deserves the best possible start in life and should be raised by a healthy family in a caring, prosperous community. With cooperative community-based programs and services, the Northeast Florida Healthy Start Coalition is dedicated to reducing infant mortality and improving the health of children, childbearing women and families throughout Northeast Florida.

The Northeast Florida Healthy Start Coalition, Inc. was organized in 1992 as part of a statewide network of community-based organizations. Our Coalition serves Baker, Clay, Duval, Nassau and St. Johns counties and served over 20,501 families in 2012.

ROUNDS AT THE GROUNDS

Rounds at the Grounds is quickly becoming one of Jacksonville's most anticipated annual fundraisers. Held each summer, Rounds features area doctors competing in a celebrity softball tournament at the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville prior to a Jacksonville Suns' game. The event raises awareness about the high infant mortality rates

in Jacksonville and provides strategies to improve birth outcomes. Jacksonville Jaguar and Healthy Start Ambassador Eugene Monroe coached last year's teams and local broadcast personality Al Emerick served as commentator. The event averages 500 attendees, this year our goal is \$60,000 – but we need your help!

INFANT MORTALITY IN NORTHFAST FLORIDA

Infant mortality, the death of a baby in the first year of life, is considered a sentinel indicator of the health of a community. It is linked to poverty, education, housing, community and family violence, and access to basic health care. Florida's infant mortality rates are among the highest in the nation, and outcomes in Jacksonville are worse than the state. In 2012, 127 babies in Northeast Florida died before their first birthday. Jacksonville also experieneces significant health disparities, with black babies dying at twice the rate of white babies. The leading causes of death are prematurity, low birth weight, birth defects and sleep-related deaths.

WHERE THE MONEY GOES

We're fortunate to have won a challenge grant from a local philanthropic organization, which will match money raised from Rounds at the Grounds dollar for dollar. This money supports the continuation of Healthy Start's "Make a Noise! Make a Difference!" initiative, which educates the community about Jacksonville's high infant mortality rate and provides strategies to prevent these needless infant deaths. This year's activities will focus on health education and community outreach, empowering community members to act as lay health advocates in their own neighborhoods. A portion of proceeds will also help support one of Healthy Start's community-based initiatives, the Azalea Project, which faces possible closure following deep city budget cuts. The Azalea Project, a case management and outreach facility working to reduce Jacksonville's high rate of infant deaths, focuses on substance-involved women of childbearing age.


