The FOCEP CBE program consists of theory and practice. To complete the program, each student must:

- Have a minimum of a High School Diploma or GED.
- Complete the course of classroom instruction in FOCEP childbirth education.
- Observe a series of childbirth classes taught by an experienced childbirth educator or FOCEP preceptor.
- Teach one childbirth education class series with a FOCEP approved preceptor or instructor.
- Observe at least two vaginal labor and births.
- Tour your local birth facilities.
- Attend a maternal child health community meeting.
- Pass the FOCEP exam with a minimum 80% score.
