# Infant deaths: local rate shoots up again

Baker County's infant mortality rate shot back up last year to 11.9 deaths per 1000 lives births, which is roughly twice the state rate and bucked a regional trend downward from 8 deaths per 1000 live births to 7.1 deaths, recently released figures show.

The release came this month during Infant Mortality Awareness Month when public health officials attempt to highlight the is-

Infant mortality is defined as the death of a child before its first birthday.

Baker County's infant mortality rate typically fluctuates widely because a relatively small change in the number of deaths — like the



On a positive note, however, Baker County had no fetal deaths, also known as stillbirths, last year, after decades of having at least a few each year, state data shows.
